Catering

Promoter will arrange to provide catering in the dressing room at the time of arrival:

- a selection of fresh fruit and vegetables
- a variety of sandwiches and salads
- an assortment of chips and snacks
- appropriate condiments like mustard, mayonnaise, and ketchup
- appropriate cutlery, plates, napkins, and cups
- 4 bottles of water (for the dressing room)
- 8 bottles of water (for the stage)
- Tea, coffee and hot water, with sugar, honey, and milk/creamer
- note: the team has no dietary or allergy restrictions

Merchandise:

The Promoter will provide a secure, well-lit area for the band or team to set up a merchandise booth.

It must be easily visible to the attending audience and provided at no cost to the Artist.

The merchandise area must include a table at least 6 feet long for the exclusive use of the Artist and the team.

Hotel Accommodations

The Promoter agrees to arrange to reserve of 4 single rooms with king or Queen-size beds

The Promoter agrees to provide full details about the hotel and reservations (website, reservation codes, plan, parking location) to the Artist and their team four weeks in advance of the show.
